

# OUR SESSIONS, FEES AND FUNDING

The Nursery at Bengeworth CE Academy welcomes children from 3 years old, providing childcare Monday to Friday, 8:30am - 3:30pm during term-time. Wraparound Care is available from 7.45am - 6pm. Our flexible start and finish times align with the school's drop-off and collection windows. All sessions include a nutritious snack and drink.

Children aged 3 or over will be entitled to Early Years Education Entitlement Funding (15hr funding), beginning from the start of the term after their 3rd birthday, and you may be eligible for an additional 15 hours funding making 30 funded hours each week in total. 15 or 30 hour funding can be used to pay for sessions your child attends. Wraparound Care is charged separately.

Sessions at The Nursery are booked in 3 hour blocks and cost £21 per block.

## A DAY AT NURSERY

No two days will ever be the same at Nursery but rhythms to our day will support the children in their sense of belonging and routine.

- Within each session your child will experience these rhythms:
- Arrival and self-registration
  - Child Led Learning (Play!) with purposeful interactions with staff both indoors and outdoors
  - Forest School
  - Self Care - Milk, Water and Fruit (self-selected)
  - Cooking / Baking sessions rotated throughout the week
  - Daily Storytimes
  - Focused Family Group sessions
  - End of session Family Group

## FOSTERING POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS

Positive relationships are at the core of everything we do, with both our youngest learners and you as parents and carers. By building strong connections, we foster a sense of belonging where everyone feels happy and safe to learn from mistakes. We actively seek children's interests through these relationships to engage and motivate them.

Each child will have a key person with whom they can foster strong relationships with and who will ensure learning is tailored to meet their unique needs and interests. Your child's key person will also ensure that learning is shared with you via an online platform so you can share in your child's successes and achievements.
