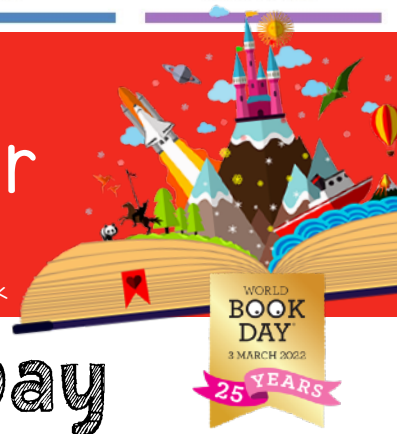

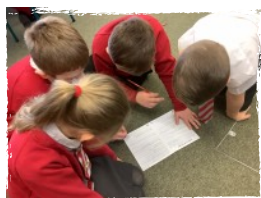
## ECO CLUB
